

Forming LNC Regions

I highly recommend forming regions at LSLA. Don't put it off till the last minute.

Another form provided in the appendix is for the convenience of state chairs. Chairs will enter into agreements with other states to form LNC regions and name representatives and alternates.

PLEASE USE THE REGION FORMATION FORM AND WRITE LEGIBLY. Regions may be formed between 90 days in advance of the Convention the second day of the Convention. In 2010, this interval runs from February 28, 2010 through the end of convention business on May 30, 2010.

States or groups of states whose membership totals 10% or more are entitled to one LNC seat for each 10% of membership they encompass. The membership percentages to use are the ones used in the determination of delegate allocation.

One LNC seat for each 10% of party membership:

- 1365 members for a Single Region (10% of 13646)
- 2730 members for a Double Region (20% of 13646)

2008 regions can provide a good informal starting point for 2010 regions; however, states can form regions with any states they want aiming for the magic 10% number.
